- 8. Candidates are prohibited from writing their names or Registered Numbers on any part of answer booklet except noting their Registered Numbers, Code number of Question Paper and Title of the Paper in the space provided for on the cover page of the Main Answer Booklet.
- 9. Candidates are prohibited from marking any identification marks including religious signs or symbols on the Main Answer Booklet which will be treated as a case of malpractice (SMP).
- 10. Candidates are prohibited from communicating either orally and exchanging forbidden materials with other candidates during the course of examination. Otherwise such candidates stand the risk of being debarred from appearing for the examination(s).
- 11. Candidates should attend examination only at the examination centre allotted to him/her.
- 12. Candidates are strictly prohibited from bringing mobiles, electronic gadgets, calculators (unless specified) and forbidden materials (such as printed, handwritten, xerox or typewritten) into the examination hall) which will be treated as a case of malpractice (SMP).
- 13. Mobiles and Handbags, if any, carried by candidates must be deposited voluntarily in the office of the Principal before the candidates present themselves in the examination hall.
- 14. Candidates are advised to verify the Date and Time of all examinations from the Time Tables displayed by the Principal/ Chief Superintendent in the notice board of the examination centre.
