1. Introduction

This College was established in 1980 with B.A (E.H.P) and B.Com.(TM) in the same building where Govt. Junior College and Govt. High School have been accommodated. Later it was shifted to its own building on Bellary Road in 2006. The Science courses were introduced in the interest and demand of the public in 1990. The College follows scrupulously academic guidelines of its affiliated SriKrishnadevaraya University, Anantapuramu. The College obtained "B" grade in the NAAC first cycle Accreditation held in February 2016 with 2.02 CGPA.






